Sign Up for *MyAccount* & Green Bill

Eliminate your paper bill by signing up for *My Account* at delmarva.com and selecting the Go Green (paperless) billing option.

Definitions:

Delivery Charges – Reflect the cost of delivering the commodity of electricity to homes and businesses via poles & wires.

Customer Charge – A fixed monthly charge which reflects the cost of maintaining your service, regardless of how much energy you use.

Distribution Charge – The cost of moving electricity from your local substation & power lines to your home or business.

Total Electric Delivery Charges – A subtotal of your Customer Charge and Distribution Charge.

Supply Charges – The cost for Delmarva Power to buy the produced electricity for you.

Standard Offer Service – Reflects the cost for Delmarva Power to buy the produced electricity if you do not choose a supplier other than Delmarva Power.

Total Electric Supply Charges – A subtotal of your Standard Offer Service Charge and Transmission Charge. This is the portion of your bill you can compare to offers from competitive suppliers. If you choose a new supplier, you will pay that supplier's price for producing electricity instead of the price you currently pay Delmarva Power.

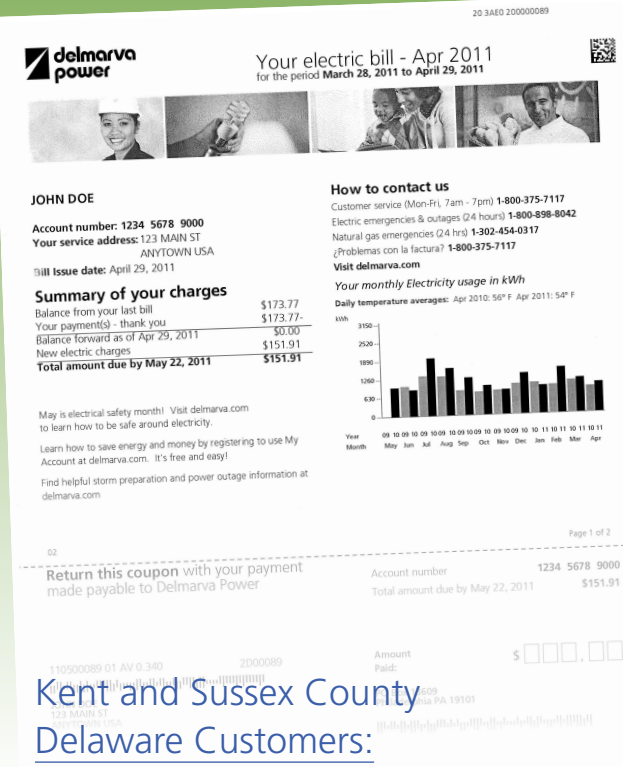
