Important Rate Information for Residential Natural Gas Customers

The Gas Cost Rate (GCR) component used in the calculation of your bill is decreasing, effective with your usage on and after March 1, 2009, due to lower wholesale natural gas prices.

With the March 1 rate change, a residential space heating customer who uses 120 centi-cubic feet (ccf) of gas per month in the winter should see a total bill decrease of approximately 4.8 percent, or \$9.30 per month from \$195.62 to \$186.32 per month. Effects of the decrease will vary with your usage. Please see the rate chart on the reverse for more details.

The GCR is a straight pass-through of wholesale costs of the gas used by our customers – Delmarva Power does not make a profit from this portion of the bill.

Delmarva Power is eager to assist customers in managing their energy costs, including offering a popular budget billing option, which helps to prevent seasonal peaks in monthly energy bills.
