Rebate Offered for A/C or Heat Pump Tune Up

Tune up your central air conditioner or heat pump and receive a \$100 rebate. Or receive up to \$300 when you replace an outdated, inefficient system.

Simply use an HVAC contractor registered in Delmarva's **HVAC Efficiency Program** to be eligible. If your system meets certain conditions, the contractor will discuss the benefits of upgrading to a more efficient unit. The rebate amount depends on the efficiency of the new appliance.

Once completed, the contractor will provide you with the rebate application. Mail it to the Delmarva Power HVAC Rebate Processing Center for payment.

Quick Home Energy Check-up – Convenient, Saves Energy Dollars

Delmarva Power's **Quick Home Energy Check-up** offers a plan to reduce your home's or apartment's overall energy use. A qualified participating contractor will evaluate ways to improve energy efficiency and identify possible health and safety issues.

Normally \$40, the inspection is conducted at no cost when you agree to have the contractor install at least three energy-saving measures at the time of the survey. These measures include installation of compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs), low-flow showerheads, tank wrap for an electric water heater, and more.

The cost is \$100, which you pay directly to the participating contractor. Since the audit is typically more than \$100, Delmarva Power pays the contractor the additional cost of \$300.

To be eligible, you must reside in a single-family, row home, townhouse or a dwelling with no more than four units. The residence must have a central air conditioner or electric heating.

Get a House Physical and Save

Customers who meet income guidelines can take advantage of our **Income Eligible Energy Efficiency Program** at no cost up to the program limit.

A certified professional conducts a comprehensive energy analysis and determines the best way to reduce your energy costs. Improvements to your home are ordered and may include new insulation, air sealing and more.

To be eligible for this program, you must reside in a single-family, row home, townhouse or a dwelling with no more than four units. Also, you must have qualified for LIHEAP or EUSP assistance in the last 12 months. And, your home must have central air conditioning or electric heating.

Community-based organizations (CBOs) in your area will determine your eligibility for program services. Call 1-866-353-5799 to find a CBO near you.

Maryland Offers Appliance Rebates

The Maryland Energy Administration is offering rebates on ENERGY STAR rated clothes washers and refrigerators, and electric heat pump water heaters.

Get a \$100 rebate for purchasing a qualifying clothes washer, a \$50 rebate for buying a qualifying refrigerator, and a \$300 rebate is yours when you purchase a qualifying water heater.

Grants Support School Projects on Energy
