

As part of Maryland's Electric Choice program, you have the right to choose an electricity supplier other than Delmarva Power. For customers who do not choose another supplier, Delmarva Power provides Standard Offer Service (SOS) at rates approved by the Maryland Public Service Commission.

Delmarva Power customers in any rate class can choose a Third Party Supplier (TPS) at any time. If you do, your new supplier must notify Delmarva Power at least 17 days prior to your scheduled meter reading date for the switch to become effective on that date. Otherwise, the switch will occur on your meter reading date the following month.

Customers in three specific rate classes - Large General Service Type 3, General Service-Primary Type 3, or General Service-Transmission - are eligible for Delmarva Power's Hourly Priced Service, a supply rate that fluctuates hourly, based upon on-going market conditions, including fuel prices and other factors. Hourly Priced Service is not available for all other customer rate classes.

Hourly pricing is the only service when a customer in these rate classes returns to Delmarva Power from a Third Party Supplier.

The Electric Choice rules may change June 1, 2006 and the eligibility requirements for Hourly Priced
