

New Rates Begin June 1 for Maryland Standard Offer Service Customers

Delmarva Power's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for Maryland residential customers will decrease June 1, 2018. If you have not chosen an alternative electricity supplier, you are on SOS and Delmarva Power buys electricity for you.

For residential customers, the new supply rates will decrease the total annual bill by about 0.4 percent. For a typical residential customer who uses about 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity a month, this will result in a monthly decrease of about \$0.62 from about \$141.82 to \$141.20 on the total bill.

The proposed new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Maryland Public Service Commission.

GENERATION AND TRANSMISSION PRICE COMPARISON INFORMATION

For customers on **Residential – Schedule “R,”** the current price for SOS electricity is 7.74 cents/kWh, effective through May 31, 2018. SOS electricity will cost 7.72 cents/kWh, beginning on June 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018. The price for SOS from October 1, 2018 through May 31, 2019 will be 7.76 cents/kWh. The weighted average price of SOS electricity will be 7.75 cents/kWh through May 31, 2019.

For customers on **Residential – Schedule “R-TOU,”** the current price for SOS electricity is 7.75 cents/kWh, effective through May 31, 2018. SOS electricity will cost 7.73 cents/kWh, beginning on June 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018. The price for SOS from October 1, 2018 through May 31, 2019 will be 7.77 cents/kWh. The weighted average price of SOS electricity will be 7.76 cents/kWh through May 31, 2019.
