

# Important Information about the Renewable Compliance Charge

Beginning in May 2016, your electric delivery charges will include more detail about the Renewable Compliance Charge which currently appears on your bill. This charge represents the costs of complying with the requirements of a Delaware law known as the Renewable Energy Portfolio Standards Act (or "REPSA").

Under REPSA, the percentage of electric supply generated from renewable energy sources must increase each year until the year 2025, when a minimum of 25% renewable energy must be achieved.

Effective May 1, 2016, your bills will include more detail about the current Renewable Compliance Charge by dividing the existing charge into two line item charges:

- Wind & Solar
- Qualified Fuel Cells

Electricity generated by Wind & Solar provides Delmarva Power customers with approximately 48% of annual REPSA compliance. Electricity generated by the Qualified Fuel Cells provides Delmarva Power customers with approximately 52% of annual REPSA compliance.

These two line items are not new charges on your bill. Dividing the existing Renewable Compliance Charge into two parts is intended to help customers better understand what portions of their delivery charges go towards renewable energy sources.
