

## New Rates Begin June 1 for Maryland Standard Offer Service Customers

Delmarva Power's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for Maryland residential customers decrease June 1, 2016. If you have not chosen an alternative electricity supplier, you are on Standard Offer Service and Delmarva Power buys electricity for you.

For residential customers, the new supply rates will decrease the total annual bill by about 4.8 percent. For a typical residential customer who uses about 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity a month, this will result in a monthly decrease of about \$6.98 from about \$144.78 to \$137.80 on the total bill.

The proposed new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Maryland Public Service Commission. This year's supply auction replaced some older, higher priced supply contracts, resulting in lower prices for customers.

## GENERATION AND TRANSMISSION PRICE COMPARISON INFORMATION

For customers on **Residential – Schedule “R,”** the current price for Standard Offer Service (SOS) electricity is 9.01 cents/kWh, effective through September 30, 2016. Standard Offer Service electricity will cost 8.38 cents/kWh beginning October 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017. The price of SOS electricity after May 31, 2017 has not yet been set. The weighted average price of SOS electricity will be 8.60 cents/kWh through May 31, 2017.

For customers on **Residential – Schedule “R-TOU,”** the current price for Standard Offer Service (SOS) electricity is 8.91 cents/kWh, effective through September 30, 2016. Standard Offer Service electricity will cost 8.28 cents/kWh beginning October 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017. The price of SOS electricity after May 31, 2017 has not yet been set. The weighted average price of SOS electricity will be 8.48 cents/kWh through May 31, 2017.
