

## Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 23, 2018 Solicitation

### Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2020.

A total of three (3) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 31% of the load, and totaling approximately 145.4 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 7 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 5 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the entire load offered.

## Delmarva Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for June 2018 through August 2018.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 58.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 7 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 4 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.
