

Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 16, 2017 Solicitation

Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2018 through May 31, 2020.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 19% of the load, and totaling approximately 87 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 5 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 4 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for December 2017 through February 2018.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 59 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 5 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 4 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.
