

Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 17, 2022 Solicitation

Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2025.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 25% of the load and totaling approximately 96 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 7 eligible bidders in the 2022-2023 RFP Procurement Process of which 5 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for December 2022 through February 2023.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 65 MW PLC at time of bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 7 eligible bidders in the 2022-2023 RFP Procurement Process of which 2 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.
