

# New Gas Rates in Effect for Commercial & Industrial Customers in Delaware

Several changes in gas rates will go into effect on November 1, 2016 resulting in an overall monthly bill increase of between approximately 0.3 percent and 10.5 percent.

The Gas Cost Rate (GCR) is adjusted annually; for the last five years the GCR has decreased. Despite the increase this year, natural gas is still the most affordable heating source for businesses this winter. We do not profit from gas supply rates as the costs are a direct pass through to customers.

Also in effect with November 1, 2016 usage will be an increase in the Environmental Surcharge Rider. This surcharge applies to all rate classes except interruptible commercial and industrial customers.
