

# NEW ELECTRIC SUPPLY RATES BEGIN OCTOBER 1 FOR MARYLAND RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Delmarva Power's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for Maryland residential customers will increase October 1, 2022. If you have not chosen an alternative electricity supplier, you are on SOS and Delmarva Power buys electricity for you.

For a typical residential customer who uses about 1,007 kilowatt-hours of electricity a month, this will result in a monthly increase of about \$17 on the total bill.

The new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Maryland Public Service Commission.
